Khadim Deme, 23 years old

Khadim was born with albinism. He grew up in a poor Fulani family, in a village on the outskirts of Senegal.



At the age of 15, parents discovered on the skin of the baby first signs of cancer diseases. Over the next few years, the disease progressed.

A course of chemotherapy was started, but due to the inability of the parents to pay for the treatment, the course had to be stopped.

In May 2020, Mila4Africa found out about Khadim and took him under guardianship.



DIAGNOSIS AT THAT TIME:

epidermoid carcinoma of the face (extensive ulcerative injury of the cheek, measuring 12 cm.) Condition: Extremely serious.

What was done:

From May 2020 to May 2021, several courses of chemotherapy, radio, and radiation therapy were carried out. As well as, daily observation, appropriate care and nutrition.

In total, treatment, maintenance and related expenses exceeded €20.000
All funds for the treatment were collected by the foundation's benefactors.

Results:

In 8 months after the last course of treatment, a biopsy confirmed the absence of the disease.

Khadim is healthy.



What is needed now:

At the moment, Khadim needs plastic surgery to restore a part of his face.

This will allow him to socialize, get an education and live a full life.

For this, it is necessary to find a clinic and specialists outside Senegal, since there are no specialists in West Africa capable of performing such a complex operation.

Also, Khadim needs adequate permanent nutrition and skin care to maintain health and prevent the recurrence of the disease.

Khadim needs a sponsor who will cover the cost of preparing for the surgery to the tune of **€20,000**.

For preparation for the surgery, tests, medicines, transport and other expenses, as well as rehabilitation, **we need €5000 monthly**.
