

# GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT QUIZ, PLEASE! [STREAM]

Here you'll find out everything you need to know about Quiz, please! [streaming version] Quiz, please! [stream] is an intellectual and entertaining battle in an online format. No need to go anywhere, you can sit on the couch (or wherever you want) and play.

How does it work?

There will be a host, several rounds, 39+ questions, summing up the intermediate and final results, fun lottery - all in an online steam version. To play, you only need the Internet: you connect to the broadcast, listen to questions, answer them and send answers in special forms. Life hack: To join the stream and connect to your teammates without missing a second of game time, it's always smart to join the broadcast 19 minutes before the game starts.

What kinds of games are there?


There are classic games, without any specific focus, and themed ones: for example [cinema and music] or Back to the 90s.

And how many participants can be in a team?

Actually, as many as you want! There can be one person in the team, or ten, or all of your friends who want to join.


And how long is the game?

The stream lasts about two hours – just enough to enjoy and have fun without becoming bored!



# GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT QUIZ, PLEASE! [STREAM]

Sounds good! I'm the team's captain, how do I get in?
Register for the game on our website, and on the day of the stream, an hour before the start, you will receive an email/SMS with links to the broadcast and a form for sending answers. You will need to send the broadcast link to all your teammates so they can join as well.



#### LEARN MORE ABOUT THE STREAM

Do I need a special app to play?

You don't need to install anything special: both the broadcast and the forms can be opened in any browser

How do I set it up?


For convenience, you'll need two devices: for example, a computer and a phone, or a laptop and a computer. In one place you start a stream, in another, you create a video or audio chat with a team in the programs that we list below (or in any other). The person who writes downs and sends your answers will need to open the form in a separate tab in order to promptly enter all the answers there.

How can we get together with the team?

To play as a team, you can use these programs to communicate:

- Zoom
- Skype
- Discord
- Hangouts

Choose the best way for you to win, and create a video, audio or text chat. We have written a short guide on how to get together with friends online.



#### HOW TO GET TOGETHER WITH A TEAM

Example - this is how a chat with a stream broadcast in Zoom looks like:

Tell me more about where to enter the answers.

We will send you a link to the form. It needs to be opened by any of the players who will be able to enter and send answers in time. Don't be confused as you'll see fields only for the first round: after submitting the answers, a link to the form for the next round will appear. You can only submit the form once, so first, make sure the answers to all the questions are filled in, your team name is spelt correctly, and all the bets (for betting rounds only) are placed. Don't worry about missing out on key info: the rules of each round will be displayed at the beginning of the form.

And where can we find the results?

You can find out how many points you scored and what place you took by clicking on the "Results" button right below the broadcast.

OK, we scored these points in the game, so what?


We came up with a separate ranking system for streams. It includes points from all online games – even special ones such as [cinema and music]. The logic is simple: the more games you play, the more points you score (they are added up after each game), the higher the rank, and the more respectful your status gets!

# 1. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT QUIZ, PLEASE![STREAM]

7 rounds.

After each round, except for Round 7, questions are repeated.

Three breaks: after Round 3, and Round 6, and Round 7.

The scheme of rounds in the classic Quiz, please! game:

Round 1. Warm-up for the lucky ones

6 questions with multiple choice options with 30 seconds of discussion each.

Questions are on completely different topics – on erudition, logic and luck.

1 point for each correct answer.

Round 2. Press the brain button

6 questions with 60 seconds of discussion each.

1 point for each correct answer.

Round 3. Shazam

6 questions with 30 seconds of discussion each.


1 point for each correct answer.

Round 4. Iron balls

You can make a bet on each question by adding the number "1" to your answer.

If the answer is correct, then you get plus 1 extra point for the question, if not, then minus 1 point for the question.

Round 5. Secret deal

6 questions, all answers to which are somehow connected, 60 seconds of discussion each.

1 point for each correct answer.

Round 6. Hardcore

3 questions with 120 seconds of discussion each.

2 points for each correct answer.

Round 7. The last chance


6 questions with 60 seconds of discussion each.

You can bet on each question by adding number the "1" or "2" to your answer. If the answer is correct, you will get plus 1 or plus 2 extra points for the question, if not, then minus 1 or minus 2 points.

Questions are not repeated.

[The scheme does not apply to themed games, Cinema and Music league games, Teens leagues, Justice leagues]

Important: The organizers of the game are entitled to change the rounds at their sole discretion.




## 2. ORGANIZATIONAL RULES [STREAM]

- 2.1 An unlimited number of players can participate in one team.
- 2.2 The total payment amount does not depend on the number of participants.
- 2.3 One hour before the game, we send links to the [stream], electronic forms for filling in your answers, as well as a backup link with a broadcast in case of technical faults. These links can be shared with all members of your team. We advise you to connect to [the stream] in advance in order to have time to establish a connection with teammates.
- 2.4 During the game, you'll need electronic gadgets to watch the broadcast and to fill out electronic forms. No additional programs are required.

It is strictly forbidden to use any electronic devices to help you answer a question, whether it is a phone, tablet, laptop, electronic watch, calculators, etc., as well as encyclopedias, other books, personal notes and records – if it helps you get an advantage over another team, it's not allowed.


2.5 The team or its members can play the same set of questions only once. In case a team or its player plays the same set repeatedly the points do not go to the overall rating. Your position will be canceled.



# 2. ORGANIZATIONAL RULES [STREAM]


2.6 An electronic form can only be submitted by one person and only once. The second time you submit won't count. It's very important to write your exact team name every time you fill out the form (the same name you registered with). After each round, the host gives 10 seconds to send in the electronic forms. After that the forms are no longer accepted. When the form for the first round is sent, a link to the second appears.

- 2.7 Before each round, it is necessary to refresh the broadcast page in order to avoid any delay. Otherwise, there is a high possibility of not having time to send the form on time.
- 2.8 During the initial registration, the team gets into the internal Quiz, please! rating system, which summarizes the scores for all games. For a certain number of scored points, the team is awarded a rank.
- 2.8.1 When two or more teams have registered under the same name, the team which has registered first gets the right to keep that name.
- 2.8.2 The name of the team must not contain obscene language, extremist slogans and emojis.
- 2.8.3 The team is entitled to change its name while keeping the points earned within two weeks from the date of the next rank receipt.



### 2. ORGANIZATIONAL RULES [STREAM]

- 2.8.4 If a team intends to change its name at any other time, it may play under that name as a new team. The points earned in this case will go to the rating of the new team and will not be summed up with the points earned under the previous name.
- 2.8.5 The points earned by the team are uploaded to the website in the league corresponding to the game in which they took part. You can find your team in a particular league by changing the filter on the website. For example, scores for classic games are included in the [classic games] ranking, and themed games are also included here, excluding [movie], [shazam] and [music party] games, which are included in the [cinema and music] ranking. There are also separate leagues [teens], [English, please!], [stream], etc.
- 2.9 If you have any questions or technical problems, you can contact us by clicking the "Contact Us" button below the broadcast.
- 2.10 You can view the subtotals by clicking the "Results" button, as well as in our group on Vkontakte.
- 2.11 All questions and answers to them contained in "Quiz, please!" are the intellectual property of Quiz, please!, LLC and are not subject to disclosure. In case of a disclosure Quiz, please! reserves the right to exclude a team/player from the game with the deprivation of points and not allow this team/player to join the games in future.



- 3.1 The correct answer is the answer that matches the author's answer and/or satisfies the offset conditions.
- 3.1.1 Offset conditions:
- a) Absolutely identical words in the answer.
- b) If the wording of the question does not require an exact answer, then allowed:
- a free interpretation, suitable in meaning and not requiring additional clarifications.

#### Example:

Question: "In fact, they are not just an element of the interior. Their appearance on screen was an important part of the show. Each reflected the character of the series, and the director considered it important to have them in the frame. What are we talking about?

### ANSWER

Drawings on the board.

But also accepted drawings on the door, and images on the door.



a) The answer to the question is not complete.

#### EXAMPIE:

We asked you to list all the states of the USA. Maybe you drew a blank and only named 40.


b) As an answer, you gave a certain general concept, part of which is the answer to the question, but did not give a specific clarification, which we were asking about.

#### FXAMPIF#1

Answer: "paper money" but you just wrote "money". The answer is incorrect because money can be coins, but the question is about paper money.

#### FXAMPIF#2

The question uses a fragment from the movie "Taxi 3" and indicates that it is necessary to name it precisely. In this case, the film "Taxi" without specifying a part does not count.



c) The question states that it is necessary to indicate a specific name/title/city, but the answer contains a descriptive characteristic.

#### **EXAMPLE:**

The question is about Jessica Rabbit, but the answer is "a red-haired woman."

d) The answer contains several answers, even a correct one too.


EXAMPLE

Question: What season of Vivaldi can you hear now? If you answer "winter, spring, summer, autumn", unfortunately, that's incorrect.

e) There is a number in the title of the film/pseudonym of the performer, which is written with a EXAMPLE 1

Question: What movie is this dialogue from?

Answer: "89 francs" is incorrect, because the film is called "99 francs".



- f) The answer contradicts the source referenced in the question.
- g) The correct answer to a question was accidentally entered in the field of another question, or if the answers are mixed up, then we have the right not to count the answer.
- i) If the question has answer options in the format "a / b / c / d", we only count them as an answer. Any other words or symbols will not be counted, even if they represent the correct answer. The same applies when there is a correct answer and a wrong letter next to it, we evaluate the letter only.


### EXAMPL

Question: How many colors does a traffic light have? a) 1; b) 2; c) 3; d) 4.
Answer "3" does not count; Answer "a) 3" also does not; Answer "three" still does not count

- j) If several words are listed in the answer, only the first of them is credited.
- 3.3 A question is considered to be invalid, if it contains a factual mistake that makes it impossible to answer correctly.
- 3.3.1 If there is an inaccuracy in the question that does not affect the logic of the answer, the question is considered to be valid.



3.3.2 If a factual mistake is found in the question or in the author's answer, then the question is removed from the game. Moreover, each team participating in the game receives the maximum score for this question, which is provided for by the rules of the correspondent round.




# 4. RULES FOR APPEALS [STREAM]

- 4.1 The decision on the disputed situation on the [stream] is made by the responsible person the Administrator, after a written request to the support service is made (by clicking the "Contact us" button).
- 4.2 Rules for the appeal submission:
- a) In the appeal, you must indicate the name of the team, the number of the round and the issue that caused the problem.
- b) Time of filing:
- Appeals and clarifications for rounds 1–6 are accepted before the start of round 7.
- In case of incorrectness of the question within the 7th round, comments on such a situation are accepted before the presentation of the final table and awards.
- Technical errors (incorrect scoring or points calculation) for rounds 1–6 are accepted before the start of round 7.
- Technical errors (incorrect scoring or points calculation) for round 7 are accepted within 24 hours after the game ends.
- c) Appealing persons:
- Only one team member can represent the interests of the team.
- On the side of Quiz, please!, the Administrator only is entitled to consider disputes and make decisions.




# 4. RULES FOR APPEALS [STREAM]

- c) In case of disagreement with the wording of the question or the correctness of the answer, the team must present a reliable source as evidence. Websites like pikabu/adme/VK, etc. are not considered reliable sources.
- d) After filing an appeal, the Administrator needs certain time to clarify the details with the editor, make a decision and announce the results of the dispute consideration.
- 4.4 If during the dispute team members show aggressive behaviour, the appeal may not be considered, and the team may be fined 3 or 5 points.



# 5. FINAL RESULTS [STREAM]

- 5.1 Positions in the game are awarded according to the number of points scored. The winner is the team with the highest amount of points.
- 5.2 If two or more teams have the same amount of points in all rounds, the teams are ranked by the last round played (the team that scored more points in round 7 would be higher in the table; if several teams scored equally in the 7th round, the results for round 6 would be compared and so on).
- 5.3 If two teams have the same amount of points in all rounds, these teams share the same position, both of them get all the goodies and prizes which are meant for the winners in this particular game.



# 6. FINAL [STREAM]
