- **With Thin Red Yarn** : Anchor Puppets 00047
(If you do not have it on hand, you can also crochet using two strands of Catania yarn held together.)
- **With Thin Cream Color Yarn** : Anchor Puppets 08926
(If you do not have it on hand, you can also crochet using two strands of Catania yarn held together.)
- **Gray** : Catania 00269 (1 pcs)
- **Red** : Catania 00424 (1 pcs)
- 3 pcs small buttons for the dress
- 2 pcs buttons to sew on the back of the dress
- **2.00 mm** crochet hook for crocheting the doll
- **2.20 mm** crochet hook for the hair and clothes
- **1.25 mm** crochet hook for some small details
- 2.5 mm electrical wire for the doll's armature

-HEAD-

I crocheted using the cross single crochet stitch, You can also crochet with regular single crochet.

We crochet the head and body with a 2.00 mm crochet hook

1. 6sc in the magic ring

2. (inc)*6 = 12sc

3. (sc, inc)*6 = 18sc

4. (2sc, inc)*6 = 24sc

5. (3sc, inc)*6 = 30sc

6. (4sc, inc)*6 = 36sc

7. (5sc, inc)*6 = 42sc

8. (6sc, inc)*6 = 48sc

9. (7sc, inc)*6 = 54sc

10. (8sc, inc)*6 = 60sc

11.-21. 60sc = 11 rows

22. 10sc, we crochet the next sc a bit looser, 9sc, we crochet the next sc a bit looser, 39sc = 60sc

(The eyes will be placed later on the single crochets that we worked loosely)

23. 60sc

24. 5sc, (inc)*6, 9sc, (inc)*6, 34sc = 72sc

25.- 27. 3 rows 72sc

(After this round, you can insert the eyes into the loosely crocheted SC)

28. (10sc, dec)*6 = 66sc

29. (9sc, dec)*6 = 60sc

30. (8sc, dec)*6 = 54sc

31. (7sc, dec)*6 = 48sc

32. (6sc, dec)*6 = 42sc

33. (5sc, dec)*6 = 36sc

34. (4sc, dec)*6 = 30sc

35. (3sc, dec)*6 = 24sc

36. (2sc, dec)*6 = 18sc, SL.ST, ch 1, we are cutting the yarn.



-INSTRUCTIONS-

- We don't stuff the head too firmly before shaping it.
- Otherwise, it will be difficult to shape since there won't be any stretching allowance.
- After shaping, stuff it firmly.
- Make sure the area between the two eyes is slightly indented.

- Stuff it in a way that the forehead and cheek areas remain slightly protruded.
- Let's start by shaping the face first. Since the face shaping is the same as in Maysa Doll, I'm leaving the link to Maysa. We will only skip the pulling at the chin area. For this reason, I'm sharing the link to Maysa Doll.

- We embroider the eyes and eyelashes using embroidery thread. If you don't have it, you can use two strands of your amigurumi yarn and embroider with the remaining two strands.
- Embroider the eyebrows 5 rows above the eye, with a length of 4sc.
- When embroidering the white of the eye, do not separate the yarn into strands.
- We embroider the nose one round below the eyes, using a wrapping technique, over a length of 3sc.
- Embroider the mouth 4 rows below the nose, 2sc long.



-FEET and LEGS-

- I use wire throughout the entire body. I bring the wires from the hands, arms, and legs together at the neck. I attach the wire after finishing the doll, which can be a bit tricky. If you want to avoid difficulty, you can insert the wire gradually as you crochet each part.
- Stuff the inside every 9 - 10 rows to prevent gaps from forming.

1. Make ch 7. - onto the chain - 5sc, w, 4sc, inc = **14sc**

Our starting point will be here.

2. (6sc, inc)*2 = **16sc**

3.- 7. 16sc = 5 rows

8. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **6sc**

9. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **5sc**

10. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **4sc**

11. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **1sc**

We place the stitch marker here.

This will be our new starting point.

12. From the back: 2sc, from the side: 3sc, from the front: 9 SL ST, from the side: 3sc, and from the back: 1sc = **18sc**

13. 5sc, 1dec, 6sc, 1dec, 3sc = **16sc**

14. 1dec, 3sc, 1dec, 5sc, 1dec, 2sc = **13sc**

15.- 16. **13sc = (2 rows)**

17. 1inc, 12sc = **14sc**

18. 1sc, 1inc, 12sc = **15sc**

19. **15sc**

20. 2sc, 1inc, 12sc = **16sc**

21. 3sc, 1inc, 12sc = **17sc**

22.- 24. **17sc = (3 rows)**

25. 4sc, 1inc, 12sc = **18sc**

26. 5sc, 1inc, 12sc = **19sc**

27.- 29. **19sc = (3 rows)**

30. 6sc, 1inc, 12sc = **20sc**

31.- 33. **20sc = (3 rows)**

34. (3sc, 1dec)*2, 10sc = **18sc**

35. 2sc, 1dec, 1sc, 1dec, 11sc = **16sc**

36. 10sc, (1inc)*3, 3sc = **19sc**

37. **19sc**

38. 4sc, 1inc, 14sc = **20sc**

46.-49. 22sc = (4 rows)

50. Right Leg : 13sc, ch 1, We are cutting the yarn.

Left Leg : 22sc, do not cut the yarn, we will continue with the body.

- **For me, the finishing point on both legs is exactly at the middle of the inner side of the leg. If it doesn't match up for you, you can crochet a few single crochets less or more.**



-THE BODY-

1. We continue from where we left off on the left leg.

Make **chain 3** - Make a single crochet into the same stitch as the last single crochet of the right leg, **22sc** right leg circumference - onto the chain **3sc** - Make a single crochet into the same stitch as the last single crochet of the left leg - **22sc** left leg circumference - onto the chain **3sc**. **This will be our starting point.**

(44sc around the right and left leg + 6sc over the chain + we made 2sc into the same place as the last sc on both the right and left leg = TOTAL 52sc)

2.-12. 52sc (11 rows)

13. 12sc, 1dec, (5sc, 1dec)*3, 17sc = 48sc

14. 12sc, 1dec, (4sc, 1dec)*3, 16sc = 44sc

15. 12sc, 1dec, (3sc, 1dec)*3, 15sc = 40sc

16.-28. 40sc = 13 rows



-HANDS and ARMS-

1. **6sc** in the magic ring

2. **(1sc, 1inc)*3 = 9sc**

3. **1inc, 3sc, 1inc, 4sc = 11sc**

4. **11sc**

5. **4sc, 3TR in the same single crochet, 6sc = 13sc**

6. **4sc, m, 6sc = 11sc**

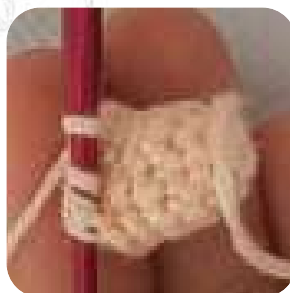
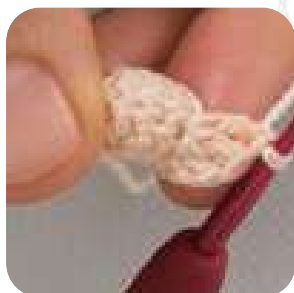
7. **1dec, 5sc, 1dec, 2sc = 9sc**

8. **9sc**

9. **1inc, 2sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc = 12sc**

10.-35. 12sc = 26 rows

36. In this row, we crochet until the end point aligns with the center of the inner sides of both arms, Then chain 1 and cut the yarn.



-ARM JOINING-

1. Continue the body from where we left off. 10sc, 3sc from both the arm and the body, 16sc, 3sc from both the arm and the body, 8sc = **40sc**

2. 9sc, make one decrease at the joining point of the arm and body, **7sc** over the arm, make one decrease at the joining point of the arm and body, **14sc**, make one decrease at the joining point of the arm and body, **7sc** over the arm, make one decrease at the joining point of the arm and body, **7sc** = **48sc**

3. (6sc, 1dec)*6 = **42sc**

4. (5sc, 1dec)*6 = **36sc**

5. (4sc, 1dec)*6 = **30sc**

7. (3sc, 1dec)*6 = **24sc**

Those who did not insert the wire at the beginning can insert it after this round.

8. (2sc, dec)*6 = **18sc**

9.-14. 18sc, At the end, make SL ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn = **6 rows**





-BABY BONNET-

I crocheted using the regular single crochet technique with a 2.20 mm hook.

1. 6sc in the magic ring
2. (inc)*6 = 12sc
3. (1sc, 1inc)*6 = 18sc
4. (2sc, 1inc)*6 = 24sc
5. (3sc, 1inc)*6 = 30sc
6. (4sc, 1inc)*6 = 36sc
7. (5sc, 1inc)*6 = 42sc
8. (6sc, 1inc)*6 = 48sc
9. (7sc, 1inc)*6 = 54sc
10. (8sc, 1inc)*6 = 60sc
- 11.-19. 60sc = 9 rows
20. We return with 1 chain, SL.ST, dc-inc , again SL.ST, dc-inc.
We crochet this way until the end of the round.
At the end, chain 1 and fasten off.
Sew the bonnet onto the head.



-ROSE-

We crochet with thin Red yarn and a 1.25 mm hook.

1. Make ch 58 - Skip 2 chains, DC in the 3rd chain, ch 3, DC in the same chain; skip 2sc, DC in the 3rd chain, ch 3, DC in the same chain

We continue in this way until the end of the row.

We return with 1 chain. We will fill in the gaps above.

(The gaps are shown in the photos.) Work each gap as follows.

sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc. We fill each gap this way until the end of the row.

At the end, chain 1 and fasten off.

Roll the piece as shown in the photos to form a rose and sew it onto the bonnet.

-PARTS MADE WITH WHITE YARN-

1. Make ch 7 - onto the chain - 2. from the chain on - sc, hdc, 3dc, 5TR in the same single crochet, 3dc, hdc, sc, SL.ST, ch 1, We are cutting the yarn.

We crochet two more pieces in the same way and sew them onto the bonnet.

-HAIR - WIG-

I crocheted using the reverse single crochet technique with a 2.20 mm hook.

1. 6sc in the magic ring

2. (inc)*6 = 12sc

3. We will make the hair strands. Make chain 42 - onto the chain - 3. from the chain on 40HDC, SL ST in the next single crochet - again chain 42 - onto the chain - 3. from the chain on - 40HDC - SL ST again into the single crochet where you made the last hair strand, and SL ST in the next single crochet.

(In this way, we have made two hair strands into each single crochet.)

We crochet this way to the end of the row, making 2 hair strands in each single crochet. At the end, chain 1 and fasten off. You will have a total of 24 hair strands.

Make one more piece in the same way and sew them onto the right and left sides of the bonnet.



-DRESS-

We crochet using the cross single crochet technique.

1. We crochet all the clothes and accessories with a 2.20 mm hook. With red yarn, chain 25- onto the chain - 2. from the chain on $(2sc, inc)*8 = 32sc$

2. We return with 1 chain, **32sc**

3. We switch to the gray yarn, We return with 1 chain, $(3sc, inc)*8 = 40sc$

4. We switch to the red yarn, We return with 1 chain, **40sc**

5. We return with 1 chain, $(4sc, inc)*8 = 48sc$

6. We switch to the gray yarn, We return with 1 chain, **48sc**

7. We switch to the red yarn, We return with 1 chain, $(5sc, inc)*8 = 56sc$

8. We return with 1 chain, **56sc**

9. We switch to the gray yarn, We return with 1 chain, $8sc, ch 6, skip 12sc, 16sc, ch 6, skip 12sc, 8sc = 44sc$

10.-11. We switch to the red yarn,
We return with 1 chain, **44sc = 2 rows**

12. We switch to the gray yarn, We return with 1 chain, **44sc**

13.-14. We switch to the red yarn,
We return with 1 chain, **44sc = 2 rows**

15.-17. We switch to the gray yarn,
We return with 1 chain, **44sc = 3 rows**

18. We switch to the red yarn, We work this round in FLO and join both ends of the piece with single crochet.

$(sc, inc)*22$. **This will be our new starting point. = 66sc**

(We continue by working this round and the following rounds in reverse single crochet.)

19. $(2sc, inc)*22 = 88sc$

20.-35. **88sc = 16 rows**

36. $(dec)*44 = 44sc$

37. 44sc, SL.ST, ch 1, we are cutting the yarn.



-GRAY PIECES ON THE DRESS WAIST-

1. We determine our starting point.

If we are making the left piece, skip 9sc forward; if we are making the right piece, skip 9sc backward. Attach the yarn to the 10th single crochet and work **(1sc, 1inc)*6, 1sc = 19sc**

(We are now at the center front of the dress.)

2. We return with 1 chain, 1sc, **(2sc, inc)*6 = 25sc**
3. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **24sc**
4. We return with 1 chain, **24sc**
5. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **23sc**
6. We return with 1 chain, **23sc**
7. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc **22sc**
8. We return with 1 chain, **22sc**
9. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **21sc**
10. We return with 1 chain, **21sc**
11. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **20sc**, ch 1 and cut the yarn.

We crochet the other piece in the same way.

Then we work one round of single crochet around both pieces



-NECK PIECE OF THE DRESS-

With a 1.25 mm hook, separate the gray yarn and crochet using only the remaining two plies

1. Make chain 25 - onto the chain - 2. from the chain on - **make 24sc.**
- 2.-4. We return with 1 chain, 24sc, At the end, chain 1 and cut the yarn. = **3 rows**
5. From the starting point, skip 5sc and attach the yarn to the 6th single crochet. Work 14sc
6. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **13sc**
7. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **12sc**
8. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **11sc**
9. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **10sc**
10. We return with 1 chain, skip 1sc, **9sc**,
Without fastening off, work one round of single crochet around the piece.
Finish with SL ST, chain 1 and fasten off.
11. For the thin long piece, chain 20. onto the chain - 18sc, w, 17sc, 1inc, SL ST, ch 1 - and cut the yarn. Sew both pieces onto the dress as shown in the photo.
Sew three small buttons onto the long piece.



-DRESS SLEEVES-

I crocheted using the reverse single crochet technique.

1. On the opening we made for the sleeve, work 20 stitches with gray yarn.

This will be our starting point.

- 2.-3. We switch to the red yarn, **20sc = 2 rows**
4. We switch to the gray yarn, **20sc**



5.-6. We switch to the red yarn, **20sc = 2 rows**

7. We switch to the gray yarn, **20sc**

8.-9. We switch to the red yarn, **20sc = 2 rows**

10. We switch to the gray yarn, **20sc**

11.-12. We switch to the red yarn, **20sc = 2 rows**

13.-19. We switch to the gray yarn, **20sc**, at the end, SL ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn = 7 rows

-ROSE-

We crochet with thin red yarn and a 1.25 mm hook.

1. Make chain 33 - onto the chain - skip 2sc - DC in the 3rd chain - make ch 3 - Again, DC in the same 3rd chain - skip 2sc - DC in the 3rd chain - make ch 3 - Again, DC in the same 3rd chain.

We continue in this way until the end of the row.

2. We return with 1sc and will fill in the gaps above.

Work this way in each gap - sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc.

We fill each gap this way until the end of the row.

At the end, chain 1, and cut the yarn.

Roll the piece as shown in the photo to form a rose and sew it onto the dress.

-ROSE - WHITE PIECES-

1. We crochet with thin white yarn and a 1.25 mm hook.

Make chain 5 - onto the chain - sc, hdc, dc, 5 HDC in the same single crochet, dc, hdc, sc, SL.ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn.

We make two more pieces in the same way and sew them onto the dress.

For the buttonhole, attach the yarn at the back bottom - ch 7, 13sc, ch 7, sc, chain 1, and cut the yarn.



-UNDERWEAR-

I crocheted using the reverse single crochet. I'm using a 2.20 mm hook.

1. With Red color yarn - chain 23 - Join the two ends of the chain with single crochet. onto the chain - make 23sc - **Our starting point will be here.**
2. **23sc**
- 3.-8. We switch to the gray yarn, 23sc, At the end, chain 1, and cut the yarn. = **6 rows**
Make one more piece in the same way, but do not cut the yarn.
Continue by joining the legs.
9. Make ch 2. - Make a single crochet into the same stitch as the last single crochet of the first leg - 23sc first leg circumference - onto the chain 2sc - Make a single crochet into the same stitch as the last single crochet of the second leg - 23sc second leg circumference - onto the chain 2sc = 52sc - **This will be new our starting point.**
- 10.-22. **52sc = 13 rows**
23. (5sc, dec)*2, 23sc, dec, 5sc, dec, 6sc = **48sc**
24. (4sc, dec)*2, 23sc, dec, 4sc, dec, 5sc = **44sc**
25. We return with 1 chain, **44sc**
26. SL.ST - ch 1 - **44sc** - SL.ST - ch 1 - cut the yarn.



-SHOES-

I crocheted using a 2.20 mm hook and the cross single crochet technique.

1. Make chain 10 - onto the chain - 8sc, w, 7sc, inc = **20sc**
2. SL.ST- ch 1-inc, 7sc, (inc)*3, 7sc, (inc)*2 = **26sc**
3. SL.ST, ch 1- (sc, inc), 7sc, (sc, inc)*3, 7sc, (sc, inc)*2 = **32sc**
4. Crochet this row using BLO - SL.ST - ch 1 - **32sc**
- 5.-6. SL.ST, ch 1, 32sc = **2 rows**
7. SL.ST, ch 1, 11sc, dec, (sc, dec)*2, 13sc = **29sc**
8. SL.ST, ch 1, 10sc, (dec)*3, 13sc = **26sc**
9. SL.ST, ch 1, 7sc, dec, (sc, dec)*2, 11sc = **23sc**
10. SL.ST, ch 1, 6sc, dec, (sc, dec)*2, 7sc, dec = **19sc**
11. SL.ST, ch 1, 7sc, M, 9sc = **17sc**
12. SL.ST, ch 1, 7sc, W, 9sc = **19sc**
13. SL.ST, ch 1, 8sc, W, 10sc = **21sc**
14. SL.ST, ch 1, 9sc, W, 11sc = **23sc**
15. SL.ST, ch 1, cut the yarn.
16. in the 4th row, attach the gray yarn to the other side of the stitches worked in BLO.
ch 1-SL ST in the next single crochet - ch 1 - SL ST in the next single crochet
Continue in this manner until the end of the row, then ch 1 and cut the yarn.
17. Use a 1.25 mm hook to make the roses on the shoes.
Chain 22 with thin red yarn
onto the chain - "SL.ST-dc-SL.ST ** Repeat in this manner until the end of the row
Make one more piece and shape it into a rose. Sew it onto the shoe.



-LADYBUG-

-HEAD- Crocheted using the cross single crochet technique with a 2.20 mm hook.

1. 6sc in the magic ring
2. (inc)*6 = 12sc
3. (sc, inc)*6 = 18sc
4. (2sc, inc)*6 = 24sc
5. (3sc, inc)*6 = 30sc
6. (4sc, inc)*6 = 36sc
7. (5sc, inc)*6 = 42sc
- 8.-15. 42sc = 8 rows
16. (5sc, dec)*6 = 36sc
17. (4sc, dec)*6 = 30sc
18. (3sc, dec)*6 = 24sc
19. (2sc, dec)*6 = 18sc
20. (1sc, 1dec)*6 = 12sc

Once this row is complete, fill the piece with stuffing

21. (dec)*6, SL.ST, ch 1, cut the yarn.
 - Embroider the eyes between rows 12 and 13, leaving 5sc between them, each eye 3sc long, as shown in the picture.
 - Embroider the nose 3sc long using the wrapping technique.
 - Embroider the eyebrows 3sc long, positioned 3sc above the eyes.

-BABY BONNET-

Work a bit more loosely to match the size of the head.

1. With Gray Color Yarn - 6sc in the magic ring
2. (inc)*6 = 12sc
3. (sc, inc)*6 = 18sc
4. (2sc, inc)*6 = 24sc
5. (3sc, inc)*6 = 30sc
6. (4sc, inc)*6 = 36sc
7. (5sc, inc)*6 = 42sc
- 8.-14. 42sc, At the end, work a SL ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn.

-CROCHET HEARTS-

Crochet using fine red yarn and a 1.25 mm hook.

1. 6sc in the magic ring
2. (inc)*6 = 12sc
3. 12sc, ch 1-cut the yarn. Make one more piece in the same way, but do not cut the yarn. We will join the pieces together.
4. Continue with the joining. Work around the first piece - 12sc, Then work around the second piece -12sc.
This will be our starting point. = 24sc
5. 24sc
6. (2sc, dec)*6 = 18sc
7. 18sc
8. (sc, dec)*6 = 12sc
9. 12sc, *** After this row, you may begin stuffing.





10. (dec)*6, *** At the end, chain 1, leave a yarn tail, and cut the yarn.

Make one more piece in the same way.

Cut a piece of wire and apply glue to one end, inserting it into the heart.

Apply glue over the wire and wrap the yarn tail around it.

Attach the other end of the wire to the head with glue.

-HAIR - WIG-

1. 6sc in the magic ring

2. (inc)*6 = 12sc

3. We will make the hair strands. Chain 18

3. from the chain on - onto the chain - 16HDC - skip 1sc - Work 2 SL.ST into the next single crochets, then chain 18 again and repeat this process to the end of the row.

At the end, chain 1 and cut the yarn.

There should be 6 hair strands in total.

Make one more piece in the same way and sew it onto the head.



-CROCHET THE WINGS-

Crochet using a 2.20 mm hook and bulky red yarn.

1. **6sc** in the magic ring
2. **(inc)*6 = 12sc**
3. **(sc, inc)*6 = 18sc**
4. **(2sc, inc)*6 = 24sc**
5. **(3sc, inc)*6 = 30sc**
6. **(4sc, inc)*6 = 36sc**
7. **(5sc, inc)*6 = 42sc**
8. **42sc**, Finally, make a SL.ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn.
Make one more piece in the same way and sew it onto the body.



-THE BODY-

Crochet using Gray Yarn

1. **6sc** in the magic ring
2. **(inc)*6 = 12sc**
3. **(sc, inc)*6 = 18sc**
4. **(2sc, inc)*6 = 24sc**
5. **(3sc, inc)*6 = 30sc**
- 6.-9. **30sc = 4 rows**
10. **(3sc, dec)*6 = 24sc**
11. **24sc**
12. **(2sc, dec)*6 = 18sc**
- 13.-14. **18sc = 2 rows**
15. **(sc, dec)*6**, Finish with a SL.ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn. **(12sc)**



-FEET and LEGS-

1. Make chain 5 - onto the chain - **3sc, w, 2sc, inc = 10sc**
 2. **inc, 2sc, (inc)*3, 2sc, (inc)*2 = 16sc**
 - 3.-4. **16sc = 2 rows**
 5. **5sc, (dec)*3, 3sc, dec = 12sc**
 - 7.-10. **12sc = 4 rows**
- You can stuff the piece after this row.
11. **(dec)*6**, SL.ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn.
- Make one more piece in the same way and sew it onto the body.



-ARMS-

1. 6sc in the magic ring

2. (inc)*6 = 12sc

3.-7. 12sc = 7 rows

Once this row is complete, lightly stuff the piece with a small amount of fiberfill.

8. (dec)*6, SL.ST, chain 1, and cut the yarn.

Make one more piece in the same way and sew it onto the body.
