

LLC Avitrans increases its stake in RusHydro to 5.96%

May 3, 2018. Moscow, Russia. PJSC RusHydro (ticker symbol: MOEX, LSE: HYDR; OTCQX: RSHYY) announces that it has received a notification from LLC Avitrans, confirming that it has increased its share in the Company to 5.9565%.

As of April 16, 2018 LLC Avitrans held 25,391,737,466 shares in PJSC RusHydro, representing 5.9565% of the share capital and voting rights in the Company. LLC Avitrans previously held a 3.066% stake in PJSC RusHydro or 13,068,024,458 shares.

Mikhail Shelkov is a controlling person of ZAO Biznes Alyans Company, which is a controlling company of LLC Promishlennie Investitsii. LLC Promishlennie Investitsii is a controlling company of CADOR ENTERPRISES LIMITED and JIVANTA VENTURES LIMITED, which in turn are shareholders of PJSC VSMPO-AVISMA Corporation and have an equal share ownership of 30% minus one share. PJSC VSMPO-AVISMA Corporation holds 100% of shares and voting rights in LLC Avitrans.

RusHydro Group is one of Russia's largest generating companies. RusHydro is the leading producer of renewable energy in Russia with over 70 generating facilities in Russia and abroad. The company also manages a number of R&D, engineering and electricity retail companies. Group's thermal assets are operated by subsidiary – RAO Energy System of East in the Far East of Russia. Total electricity generation capacity of the Group is 39 GW, heat capacity – 16.2 thousand GCal/h.

Russian Federation owns 60.56% in RusHydro, the rest is held by other institutional and individual shareholders (over 360,000). The company's stock is traded on Moscow Exchange (MOEX), and included in MSCI EM µ MSCI Russia indexes. Company's GDRs in the IOB section of LSE, ADRs – in OTCQX.
