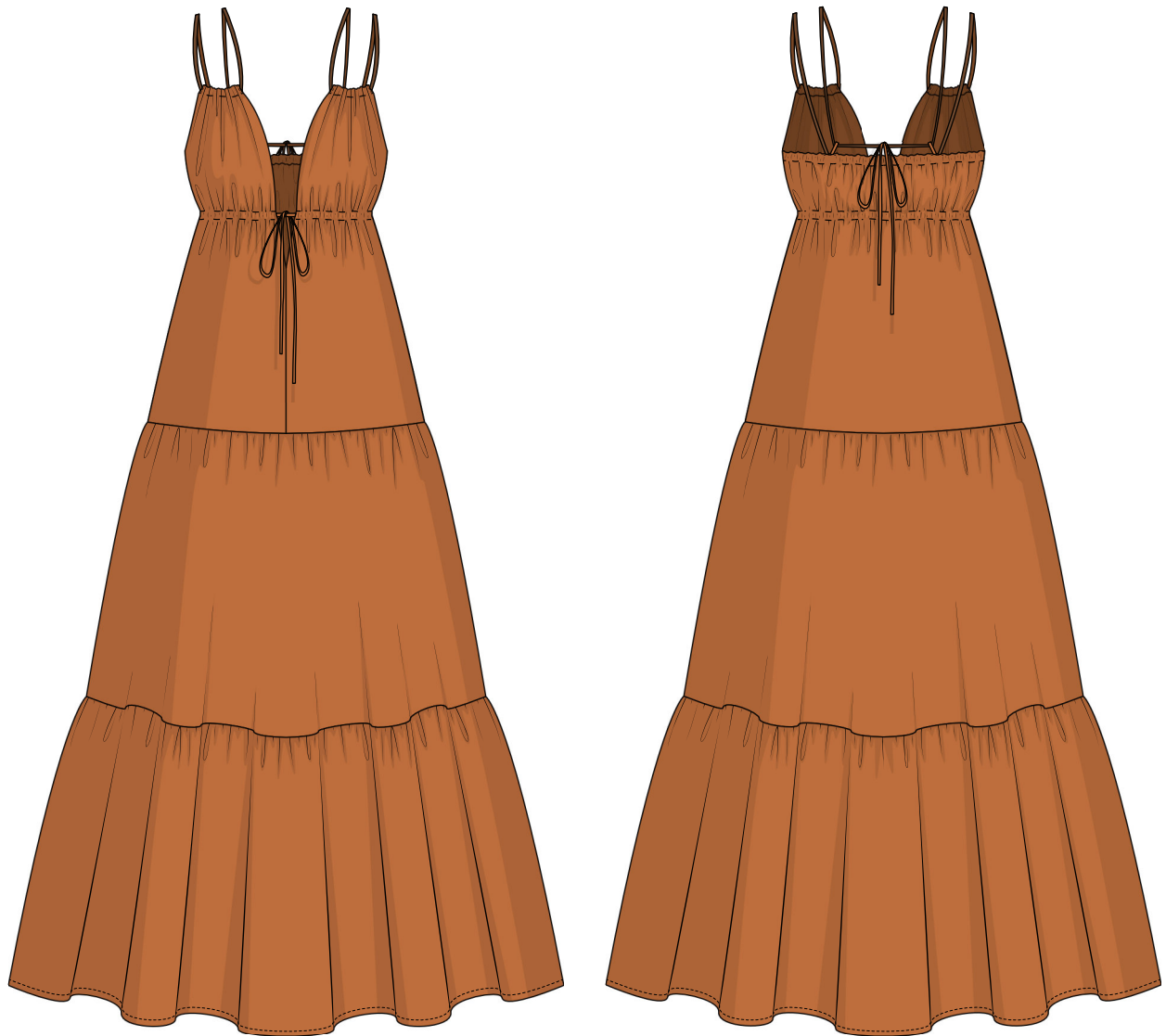

CELINE PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Celine is a loose-fitting A-line tiered dress with double straps. The dress features casings above and below the bust that are threaded with ties for gathering. Celine is above-ankle length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose dress-weight fabrics with the following properties:

- medium weight, soft, with good drape, non-stretch or with very little stretch, opaque
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (silk, cotton), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (cotton + silk, silk + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane)
- we recommend using the following fabrics: dress-weight viscose, silk, artificial silk, cotton, poplin

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit fabrics and lightweight sheer fabrics (chiffon, organza, stretch lace).

The dress in the photo is made of textured cotton. The fabric is medium weight, soft, structured, and with very little stretch. The fiber content is 100% cotton.

3. Elastic, 1 cm wide, for back casing, for all heights, in meters:

Size	34	36	38	40	42	44	46	48	50	52

Elastic, 3/8" wide, for back casing, for all heights, in yards:

4. Stitched bias-cut fusible stay tape with stitch reinforcement, 1.5 cm (5/8") wide — 1 m (1 1/8 yd)

5. Matching thread — 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker)

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. This may be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- elastic threader (may be replaced with a safety pin)

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- top front — cut 2
- top back — cut 1 on fold
- back mid tier — cut 1 on fold
- front mid tier — cut 1 on fold
- back bottom tier — cut 1 on fold
- front bottom tier — cut 1 on fold
- front neck facing — cut 2
- armscye facing — cut 2
- tie strap — cut 2

- casing tie — cut 1
- casing — cut 1 on fold
- rouleau loop — cut 1 (2 pieces)

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.

2. From interfacing:

- front neck facing — cut 2
- armscye facing — cut 2

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include 1 cm (3/8") seam allowances.

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.



With the right side facing up, overlock the following:

- the center edge of the top front, from the neckline notch all the way down to the bottom edge
- 6 cm (2 3/8") of the neckline and armscye edges of the top front piece, starting at the upper edge



With the right side facing up, finish the outer edges of the armscye facing pieces with an overlocker.



Place the top front and armscye facing pieces right sides together and align the edges. Pin and machine-stitch, backstitching at the beginning and end.

The top of the armscye facing should overlap the casing stitching line by 1 cm (3/8").
