TSAIRI PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Tsairi is a semi-fitted A-line blouse with a curved front hem. The neck, center front and bottom edges feature flounces. The deep V-neckline is finished with bias binding. The blouse fastens at the front with sewn-on ties at the bust and below-the-bust ties threaded through casings. Long, straight-cut, set-in sleeves feature casings with ties at the wrists. The outer edge of the flounces and the sleeve hems are unfinished. Fraying is prevented by staystitching along the raw edges. Tsairi is below-the-hip length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew the blouse, choose blouse and dress-weight fabrics with the following properties:

- moderately lightweight, fluid, soft, non-stretch or with very little stretch, opaque or semi-sheer
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (silk, cotton), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (cotton + silk, viscose + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane)
- the following fabrics are recommended: natural silk, faux silk, chiffon, crepe de chine, viscose crepe, silk crepe, silk satin

Important! The color of the wrong and right sides of your fabric must be practically the same.

The blouse in the photo is made of natural silk. This fabric is lightweight, fluid, soft and non-stretch.

***IMPORTANT!** When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.*

2. Hemming web tape, 3 cm (1 1/8") wide, for all sizes in all heights — 10 cm (4")
3. Matching thread — 1 spool for the sewing machine

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- Sewing machine for construction
- Buttonhole foot for the sewing machine
- Loop turner

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- Front — cut 2
- Back — cut 1 on fold
- Sleeve — cut 2
- Front flounce — cut 2
- Neck flounce — cut 2
- Back flounce — cut 1 on fold
- Sleeve casing — cut 2
- Blouse casing — cut 4
- Casing tie — cut 4
- Sleeve tie — cut 4
- Front tie — cut 2 pieces
- Bias binding — cut 4

***IMPORTANT!** Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.*

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances: 1 cm (3/8") for all edges.
Take this into account when laying out the pattern pieces on the fabric.



Machine-stitch the tie openings using a buttonhole foot.

Trim the hemming web tape all around the tie openings right next to the stitching.

Press the tie openings and cut them open carefully.



Prepare the casings.

Press the long edges of the casing pieces to the wrong side by 5 mm (just under 1/4") each.



Place the sleeve casings on the sleeves following the marking, wrong sides together. Pin, baste and machine-stitch the casings at 1 mm from the edge. Backstitch at the beginning and end.

Press the seams.
