MELODY PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Melody is an empire-waist dress with a semi-fitted bodice and a voluminous skirt. The skirt is gathered along the waist seam. The dress has a round neckline and a Peter Pan collar with a ruffle trim. The long, loose-fitting set-in sleeves are gathered at the sleeve cap and 4 cm (1 5/8") above the bottom edge, where an elastic casing is attached. The dress features a center back button placket. Melody is above-knee length.

PATTERN PIECES LIST

1. From main fabric:

- front bodice — cut 1 on fold
- back bodice — cut 2
- front skirt — cut 1 on fold
- back skirt — cut 1 on fold
- sleeve — cut 2
- sleeve casing — cut 2
- upper collar — cut 2
- undercollar — cut 2
- back placket — cut 2
- neck facing — cut 1 on fold
- collar ruffle — cut 2 on fold

***IMPORTANT!** For the collar ruffle, you can use additional fabric (lace trim, broderie anglaise lace, etc.).*

2. From interfacing:

- upper collar — cut 2
- back placket — cut 2
- neck facing — cut 1 on fold

***IMPORTANT!** Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.*

SEAM ALLOWANCES

All pattern pieces include seam allowances as follows:

- garment hem allowance — 1.5 cm (5/8")
- sleeve hem allowance — 1.5 cm (5/8")
- all other edges — 1 cm (3/8").

Take this into account when laying out pattern pieces on the fabric.



Using a 4 mm stitch length, sew two parallel lines of gathering stitches along the upper edge of the decorative trim that serves as the collar ruffle. The stitching lines should be at 5 mm (just under 1/4") and 8 mm (just under 3/8") from the edge.

Gather the edge by pulling on both lower (bobbin) threads at the same time. When gathered, the ruffle should be as long as the outer edge of the upper collar. Distribute the gathering evenly.



Place the collar ruffle and upper collar right sides together, align the edges. Match the notches and pin. Machine-baste the ruffle in place at 8 mm (just under 3/8") from the edge.



Press the seam flat.
