

DEBORAH PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Deborah is a semi-fitted blouse with an accentuated waist. The front features princess seams and the back has waist darts and a center seam. The shoulder dart on the back bodice has been transferred to the neckline. The front neckline is deep, square-shaped and finished with a facing. The sleeve is set-in, short and voluminous, and the sleeve cap has overlapping pleats. The bottom of the sleeve is gathered and finished with a narrow cuff. The blouse fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam. Deborah is hip-length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this blouse, choose woven fabrics with the following properties:

- Medium to heavy weight, structured, non-stretch or with very little stretch
- The fiber content can include natural fibers (wool, silk, cotton, linen), artificial (viscose), blends (wool + silk, wool + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc), and synthetic (polyester, polyester + elastane)
- The following fabrics are recommended: heavy silk or cotton suiting, satin, poplin, linen, gabardine, jacquard, light to medium weight denim

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit materials.

The blouse on the photo is made with 100% cotton. This fabric is medium weight, soft and non-stretch.



Overlock the center back raw edges, with the rightside facing up. Press.



Pin, baste and stitch the shoulder darts on the wrong side of the back pieces.

Backstitch at the beginning of the stitching line and tie a knot at the dart point. Hide the thread tails inside the bulk of the dart with the help of a large-eye needle.



Press the dart flat.



Press the dart towards the center back.
