ISABELLE PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Isabelle is an evening gown with an accentuated waist due to the waist seam. The corset bodice of the dress is close-fitting.

The front and back of the bodice are shaped with princess seams featuring rigilene boning inserted into applied channels. There are rouleau loops at the center back for the lacing. The dress fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam.

The fabric-covered bra cups are sewn to the bodice, and the ruching over the bust area is secured at the center front and the side seams.

The low V-neckline is finished with mesh in the nude color.

The fancy sleeves are voluminous and feature draping.

The waist seam features a decorative waistband.

The full skirt is layered and flares out towards the bottom. The yoke and the outer skirt layer are gathered tightly. The skirt of the dress is finished with a free-hanging lining.

Isabelle is floor length.

PATTERN PIECES LIST

From fabric for the 1st layer:

- center back bodice — cut 2
- mid back bodice — cut 2
- side back bodice — cut 2
- side front bodice — cut 2
- mid front bodice — cut 2
- center front bodice — cut 2
- front bodice overlay — cut 4
- sleeve — cut 4
- underskirt — cut 3 on fold
- skirt yoke — cut 2 on fold
- outer skirt — cut 2 on fold (draft according to the diagram)
- lacing (may be replaced by a satin ribbon)

From fabric for the 2nd layer:

- center back bodice — cut 2
- mid back bodice — cut 2
- side back bodice — cut 2
- side front bodice — cut 2
- mid front bodice — cut 2
- center front bodice — cut 2
- front bodice insert — cut 1

From fabric for channels:

- center back channel — cut 2
- mid back channel — cut 2
- side back channel — cut 2
- mid front channel — cut 2
- center front channel — cut 2
- waistband — cut 1 on fold
- rouleau strap for corset loops

From interfacing, 30 g/m²:

- center back channel — cut 2
- mid back channel — cut 2
- side back channel — cut 2
- mid front channel — cut 2
- center front channel — cut 2

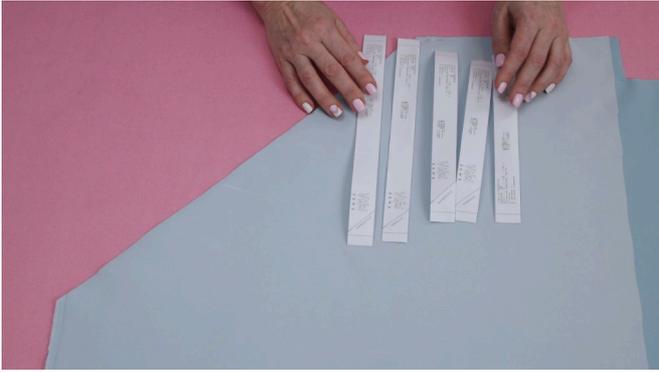
From lining fabric:

- front skirt lining — cut 1 on fold
- back skirt lining — cut 2

LACING PIECE CUT FROM FABRIC FOR THE 1ST LAYER

IMPORTANT! Don't forget to transfer all pattern markings and notches onto the fabric.



Interface a piece of fabric. Cut out the channel pieces on the bias.



Press the long edges of the channel pieces to the wrong side. You can either do it yourself or use a bias tape maker. Cut the channel pieces using the paper pattern.



Cut out the rouleau strap, 2.5 cm (1") wide, on the bias for making the corset loops. Do not interface the rouleau strap.



Divide the front and back bodice pieces into groups. Each bodice piece consists of one corsetry mesh layer and two tulle layers. Align the edges and pin.
