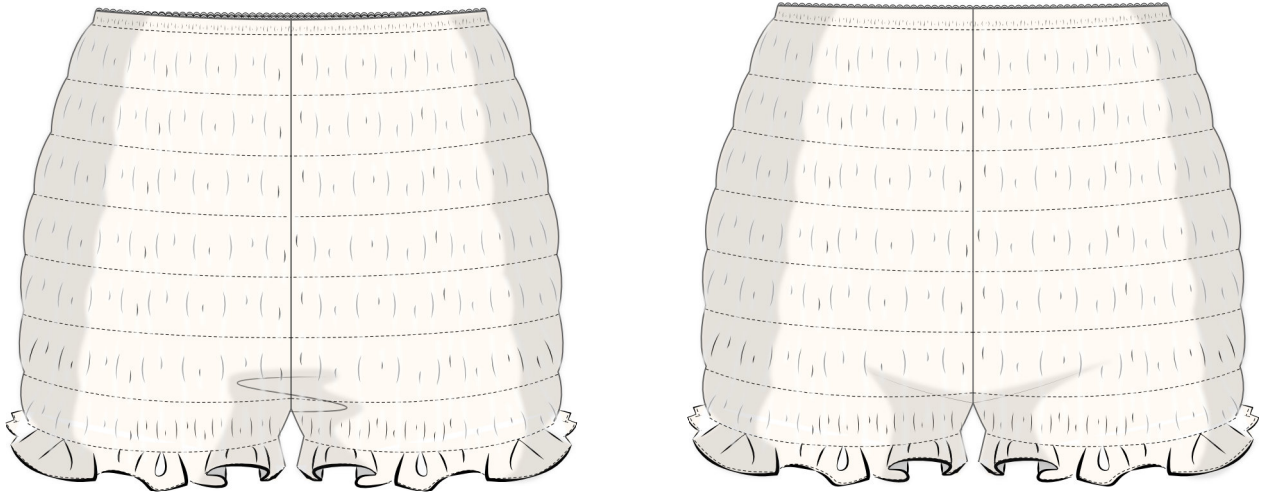

SAYARI PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Sayari is a pair of close-fitting shorts with no side seams. The shaping is achieved with rows of shirring. The upper edge of the shorts is finished with picot elastic and sits at the natural waistline. Sayari is above mid-hip length.

Press the seam allowances towards the back of the leg piece. Stretch the shirring when pressing.



Turn one leg piece right side out and insert it into the other leg piece, right sides together. Align the crotch edges, match the inseams and shirring lines, and then pin.

Machine-stitch twice, with the second stitching line going exactly over the first one. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.



Overlock the seam allowances, with the left leg facing up.

Press the seam flat.
