

HANA PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Hana is a lined, close-fitting no-hook bralette. It features horizontal seams on the cups and a center front seam. The adjustable straps are made of bra strap elastic. The bottom edge of the bralette is finished with an elastic band. Hana is above-waist length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this bralette, choose soft, stretchy, medium-weight knit fabrics made of natural fibers or blends.

The following fabrics are recommended: lingerie rib knits, jersey knits. The stretch factor should be 1.5–2.0.

Attention! We recommend using only stretchy fabrics for this bralette.

You can determine the stretch factor of the fabric yourself. Mark 10 cm (4") along the crosswise grain of the fabric, lay a ruler next to the marked section and stretch the fabric. Divide the measurement you get by 10.

The bralette in the photo is made of thin lingerie rib knit fabric. The fabric is soft, medium weight, with good stretch. The fiber content is 95% cotton and 5% spandex. The fabric weight is 210 g/m².

The bralette band is made of elastic.

FABRIC AND NOTIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Main fabric, 110 cm (43") wide, with a directional print/nap:

Size	34	36–40	42–44	46–50	52
meters	0.25	0.3	0.35	0.4	0.45
yards	1/4	3/8	3/8	3/8	1/2



Hand-baste clear elastic along the top edge on the wrong side of the outer piece to prevent the seam from stretching out.



Following the pattern markings, place the strap and ring tab to the top edge on the right side of the outer piece and pin.



Place the outer and inner pieces right sides together and align the top edges. Match the notches and side seams, and pin.
